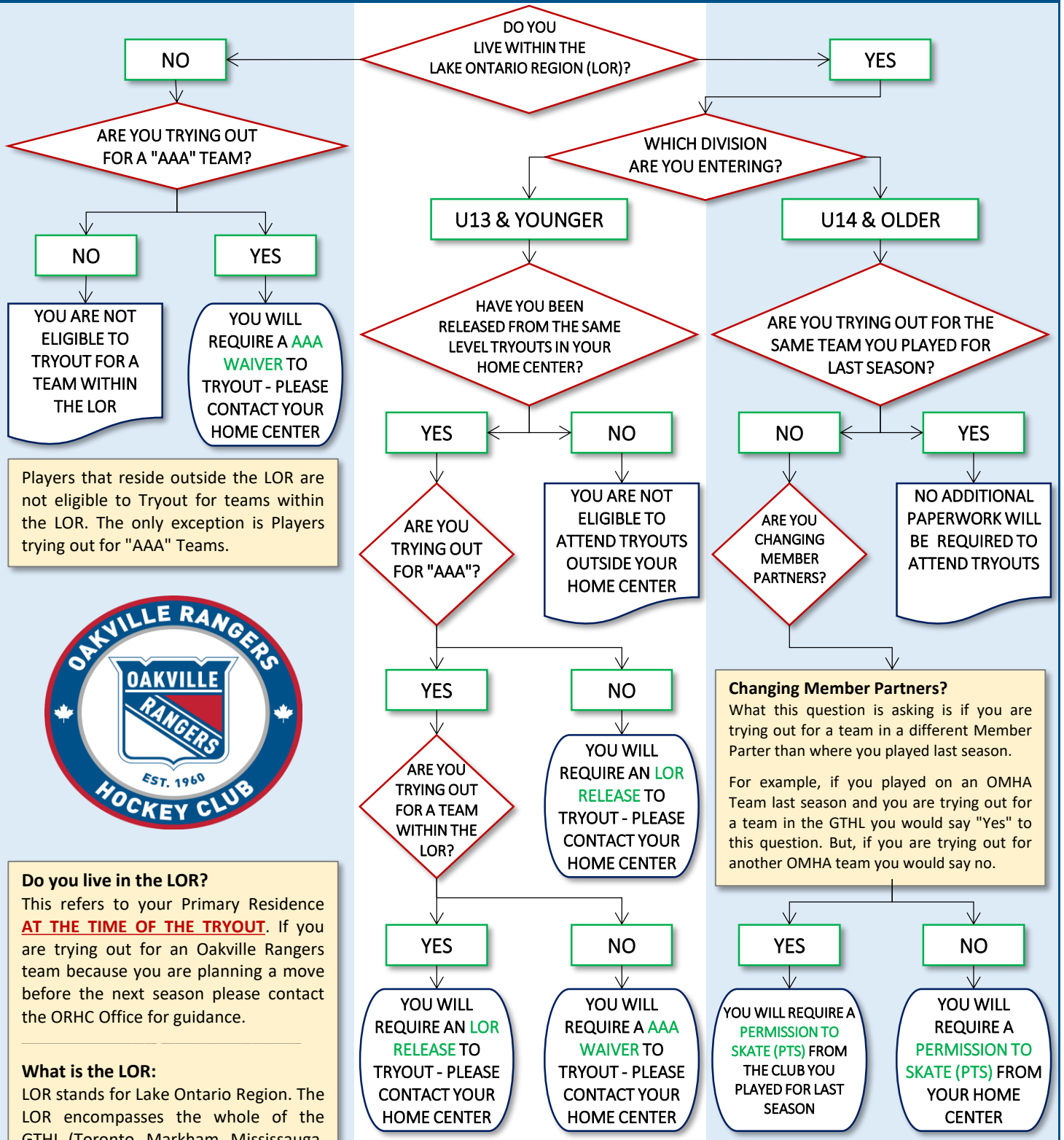


Am I going to need a PTS, Waiver, or Release?

Use the Flowchart below to help determine what Paperwork you may require to attend Tryouts

Note: the below information does not apply to U18 AAA



Players that reside outside the LOR are not eligible to Tryout for teams within the LOR. The only exception is Players trying out for "AAA" Teams.



Do you live in the LOR?
 This refers to your Primary Residence **AT THE TIME OF THE TRYOUT**. If you are trying out for an Oakville Rangers team because you are planning a move before the next season please contact the ORHC Office for guidance.

What is the LOR:
 LOR stands for Lake Ontario Region. The LOR encompasses the whole of the GTHL (Toronto, Markham, Mississauga, and Vaughan) as well as Oakville, Brampton, Richmond Hill, Markham, Ajax and Pickering. More info can be found on the OHF site at www.ohf.on.ca/rules/player-movement/lake-ontario-region/

Changing Member Partners?
 What this question is asking is if you are trying out for a team in a different Member Parter than where you played last season. For example, if you played on an OMHA Team last season and you are trying out for a team in the GTHL you would say "Yes" to this question. But, if you are trying out for another OMHA team you would say no.

Do I have to Tryout in my Home Center first?
 Players in U13 and younger are required to attend Tryouts in their Home Center to be eligible for a Release or Waiver to try out elsewhere at the same Level. For example, to tryout for a different AA team outside your Home Center you must first attend your Home Cetner's AA Tryouts, even if you are returning to the team you played for last season.
