Season Highlights

Last season, the Rangers started our journey of transforming the House League Hockey experience for our players and parents, providing more playing options to suit the desires of the player. With a focus on growing the sport, increasing player engagement, and operational excellence, this past season, we continued on the journey. It was year two of our Advanced League test in partnership with Mississauga Hockey League (MHL), where we had 18 Rangers hockey teams between U10-U18 participate in the MHL, designed for players seeking a more competitive experience. Here in Oakville, we had over 50 teams across all age groups participating in our House League program. We also saw a resurgence of our



House League Roster Select Program, with teams across every age group. This year, we also welcomed over 50 new hockey players seeking to learn, develop, and grow their hockey skills in a safe space within our Accelerated Skills Development Program.

Advanced League – Highlights

After a 'rocky' year one (22/23) of our MHL Partnership, we, like most pro expansion teams, acclimatized ourselves to a more competitive group of teams. Year two registration for this program was overwhelming and astounding. We recognize that we had to make some difficult decisions, limiting the number of teams we entered into the MHL to ensure that our teams were equally competitive. This unfortunately meant that we could not find room for every child who registered, but this did force us to make changes to our House League program to ensure we provide more opportunities within our Home House League program.

In the 23/24 season, we had 15 very competitive hockey teams across the MHL Select and Rep A divisions. Many of our teams ended the year with winning records; in fact, 6 teams made it to the MHL Semi-Finals, and 4 teams moved on to the MHL Cup Finals. Congratulations to everyone who participated in this league this past year; you made us all very proud.

And finally, YES, the Advanced Test and Partnership with the MHL was a success. In February of 2024, the OMHA and GTHL approved the extension of this program, and we're back for another season in 24/25. We are all focused on continuing to improve this experience for everyone.

The Rangers "Home" House League Hockey Program

The backbone of our club is our Home House League Hockey Program, and it is our greatest priority! While we are a not-for-profit hockey program, this year we invested in new tools and features to support our journey of facilitating the best house league hockey program in North America. We also made some changes to processes that led to more balanced hockey divisions and incredibly competitive hockey games.

Over 50 hockey teams worth of players participated in over 1000 hockey games from October through to the end of March. Our House League Playoffs and Championship Weekend were EPIC. The buzz in the rinks for those two weeks of March was unlike anything we've seen in recent years. Almost every championship game was a nail-biter! Congratulations to all players, coaches, coaching staff, and families for another awesome season.

Our **House League Rostered Select Program** proved again to be an incredible experience for every player. We had Select Teams across 6 cohorts, who competed in over 100 exhibition games with other Select clubs from across the province. This program continued to flourish in the 23/24 Season, more importantly most if not every player and parent had a lot of fun, and saw a ton of progress throughout the season. We are excited for the 24/25 season as we have entered all of our Select Teams into the newly created Tri-County Select Hockey League.



The 23/24 Season also saw the Oakville Rangers host our very first House League Hockey Tournament for all cohorts in a very long time. **The SHOWDOWN in O'TOWN** was a blast for the Rangers and the other 70-80 teams who came into Oakville to face the best of the best in House League Hockey! A lot of FUN!

As the league enters the new season, we are poised to build upon the successes of last season. We are committed to continuing to improve our House League experience.

We are excited to have Oakville Rangers Teams returning to the MHL for next season for our **Advanced Division Players**.
