The ORHC is a non-profit organization run by volunteers and a small team of full-time staff in the Club office.

Statement of Purpose:

The Oakville Rangers Hockey Club is considering the formation of a partnership for the purposes of player development and the teaching of hockey fundamentals.

Scope of Work:

- Provide input and feedback on the formation of the Oakville Rangers Hockey Club player development model and curriculum.
- Provide input and feedback on the creation of age and level appropriate lesson plans and development timelines based on the ORHC curriculum.
- Supply instructors (3 optimal), materials, resources, and equipment for all on-ice work
- Administer age and level appropriate on-ice instruction
- Player development in various avenues including initiation and tyke half ice programming and the ORHC hockey skills academy.


Interested Parties:

- Areas of specialty (e.g. learn to play, elite skill development, IP/Tyke development, etc.)
- Cost of instruction/services
- Experience and references
